Inside the House

- Test your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and change batteries immediately if needed.
- Practice your family's fire escape plan so everyone knows what to do in an emergency.
- Ensure you have an emergency preparedness kit in case of incidents such as a power outage or flood.
- Properly store household chemicals and never mix cleaning agents.
- Check your fire extinguishers.

Outside the House

- Make sure your address markers are up and clearly visible.
- Keep 100' of garden hose with an attached nozzle connected and ready for use.
- **April 1 marks the start of fire season. No burning between 7:00am and 7:00pm.**

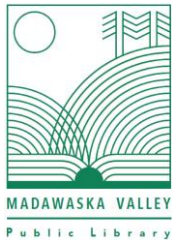
