The Township is fortunate to have the beautiful Madawaska River running through our communities. As beautiful as this river is, it can also have detrimental effects. In the spring, water levels can rise to extreme levels causing flooding. This flooding can cause extensive damage to homes and properties. To help mitigate this potentially expensive natural disaster, Brudenell, Lyndoch and Raglan Township applied for a grant to the Community Emergency Preparedness Grant where we requested funding in the amount of \$41,686.00. The application was successful and the Township was able to purchase a four-chute sandbagger, conveyer system, sandbags and trailer! This piece of equipment will allow for large quantities of filled sand bags to be produced quickly and efficiently for residents to protect their homes and properties from the losses that accompany disasters. Public safety and emergency preparedness is essential.
