In Ontario, CO (carbon monoxide) alarms are required by law in homes with fuel burning appliances, fireplaces, or attached garages. Specifically, a working CO alarm must be placed adjacent to each sleeping area in these homes.

A message from the Public Works Department Our Public Works crew has been extremely busy this year between frequent damaging storms washing out roads to reconstructing two paved roads as well as regular routine maintenance! The Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance of 62 kilometers of paved and 135 kilometers of gravel roads for a total of 197 kilometers of roads in the Township. Staffed with 7 employees that work hard to maintain roads to minimum standards or above! The Department is also responsible for fleet maintenance, culvert repair/replacement, ditching, pot hole repair, snow plowing, sanding, grading, brushing and dust control of Township roads.
