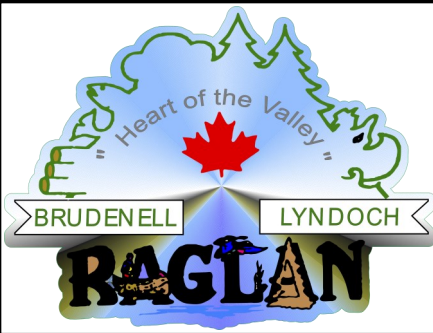

Fire Prevention and Education is key to keeping our community and residents safe. Fire Safety starts with YOU! Did you know it's the LAW to have working smoke alarms on each level of your home and outside each sleeping quarters? Did you know that BLRFD will do complimentary smoke alarm/CO checks for YOU?! Give us a call at the Township office to set up your smoke alarm check! In Ontario, CO (carbon monoxide) alarms are required by law in homes with fuel burning appliances, fireplaces, or attached garages. Specifically, a working CO alarm must be placed adjacent to each sleeping area in these homes.

Our Public Works crew has been extremely busy this year between frequent damaging storms washing out roads to reconstructing two paved roads as well as regular routine maintenance! The Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance of 62 kilometers of paved and 135 kilometers of gravel roads for a total of 197 kilometers of roads in the Township. Staffed with 7 employees that work hard to maintain roads to minimum standards or above! The Department is also responsible for fleet maintenance, culvert repair/replacement, ditching, pot hole repair, snow plowing, sanding, grading, brushing and dust control of Township roads. We are excited to announce the upcoming arrival of a new Freightliner Combination Plow Truck/Roll Off Truck! This purchase will eliminate one truck from our fleet, saving you money while allowing operations to run more efficiently!

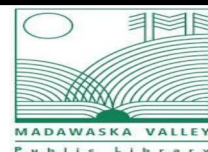
