Waste Disposal Tipping Fees and Recycling Instructions**

	Household waste in CLEAR BAGS (maximum size 31" x 46") One small 'privacy bag' is permitted for personal items if it is less than 1 cubic foot in volume.	\$2 per bag tag
	Correctly sorted, recycled material	No Charge
	Compact Pickup Truck 2 cubic yards	\$20
	Standard Pickup Truck 4 cubic yards	\$40
	Single Axle Utility Trailer 2 cubic yards	\$20
	Dual Axle Utility trailer 4 cubic yards	\$40
	Single Axle Dump Truck 8 cubic yards	\$80
	Dual Axle Dump Truck 16 cubic yards	\$160
	Tri-Axle Dump Truck 22 cubic yards	\$220
	Small Dumpster 8 cubic yards	\$80
	Large Dumpster 16 cubic yards	\$160
	Chairs, tables, sofas, beds, etc. (Brudenell site only)	\$5 each item

1. If there is a difference between the waste containing vehicle/container and one of the descriptions in this table, or if there is a dispute regarding the volume of the vehicle/container in question, the waste volume shall be measured and the cost calculated at \$10 per cubic yard.

2. Those disposing of construction or demolition waste must show proof that the waste originated in BLR Township. Proof can be in the form of a suitable permit issued by the Municipality.

3. If the volume of your glass, plastic and metal recycling is roughly equal to the volume of the garbage in your clear bag, the waste site attendant will give you a free bag tag.

4. Additional bag tags can be purchased at the Municipal Office, Waste Sites and Hannah's Foodmart.

Special Opening of the Waste Site: The Brudenell Waste Site can be opened upon request to accommodate large loads when the site would normally be closed. A \$50 charge will apply.

Please Note: Waste site users will be required to present a valid Waste Disposal Access Card. A Waste Disposal Access Card is issued to the registered owner of each residential, commercial and industrial property. Owners of vacant properties, or properties with non-assessed travel trailers, may request a waste disposal access card at the Municipal Office. Landlords are responsible for ensuring their tenants receive a card. The property owner can buy a replacement card at the BLR Municipal Office for a fee of \$10.00.

These wastes will not be accepted:

Asphalt Pavement, Biological or Pathological Waste, Hazardous Waste Including Empty Propane Tanks, Boats, Canoes and Other Marine Units, Motor Vehicle Bodies or Engines, Dead Animals, Farm Machinery, Human Sewage, Industrial or Manufacturer Waste, Mixed Waste, Petroleum-Soaked Rags or Explosives or any Other Highly Combustible Material, Tree Stumps and Vehicle Batteries.

How to Recycle

Sort your recyclables according to the table below.

Paper/Fibre	Plastic/Foam/Metal/Glass
<p>Cardboard boxes Pizza boxes, direct mail boxes, moving boxes, shoe boxes. Flatten. No larger than 60 x 60 cm.</p> <p>Boxboard Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons, rolls from toilet paper and paper towel. Flatten. Empty.</p> <p>Paper laminate packaging Pet food bags, food service paper bags, and plates. Empty and free from food residue.</p> <p>Paper laminate containers Spiral cans, cookie dough package, ice cream containers, and hot and cold beverage cups. Empty and free from food residue. Remove lids.</p> <p>Cartons Beverage cartons, juice and milk cartons, coffee creamers, and sugar cartons, soup and sauce cartons. Empty and free from food residue. Keep lids on.</p> <p>Paper Any colour, including flour bags, prescription bags, paper produce bags. Notepads, white or coloured loose paper, file folders, other printed materials. Community newspapers, flyers, brochures and magazines. Greeting cards and envelopes, gift boxes. Place shredded paper in a tied clear plastic bag. Separate from plastic bags used to cover items, remove elastic bands. Remove rope handle from bags.</p>	<p>Hard plastic containers Laundry detergent and household cleaner jugs, shampoo, body wash, salad dressing, condiment, dish soap, mouth wash bottles, plastic beverage bottles. Empty and free from food residue. Keep lids on.</p> <p>Plastic packaging and containers Food trays, salad, yogurt, peanut butter, bakery and egg containers, plastic cups, plastic tubs and lids. Empty and free from food residue. Keep lids on.</p> <p>Tubes Toothpaste tubes, deodorant, hand cream tubes. Empty and free from residue. Keep lids on.</p> <p>Small item plastic packaging Hand sanitizer bottles, medication bottles, blister packs, plant pots. Empty and free from food and residue. Keep lids on.</p> <p>Flexible plastic packaging Bags used for dry cleaning, bread, newspapers and flyers. Overwrap (paper towel & toilet paper, beverage containers). Coffee bags or deli pouches, chip bags, bubble wrap, snack wrappers, cereal liner bags, plastic gift bags. Empty and free from food residue.</p> <p>Foam packaging Meat trays, takeout containers, cups, plates, bowls, foam packaging for products. Empty and free from food residue. Remove film wrap and absorbent pads from meat trays.</p> <p>Metal containers Food cans, metal lids, cookie, coffee and tea tins, beverage cans. Empty and free from food residue.</p> <p>Aluminum (foils and trays) Aluminum foil, pie plates, frozen food trays. Empty and free from food residue. Ball up aluminum foil.</p> <p>Aerosol containers Food spray, hairspray, air fresheners, shaving cream, deodorant. Empty. Lids on. Aerosols with toxic, corrosive or flammable symbol are not accepted with the exception of: Cooking oil sprays and products designed for food, Hairsprays, cosmetics and products designed to be used on hair/skin</p> <p>Glass containers Clear and coloured glass. Food containers, jars and bottles, cosmetic containers, spice bottles, oil and vinegar bottles, non-alcoholic glass beverage containers. Empty and free from food residue. Lids off.</p>
<p align="center">Not Permitted in Blue Box: Hard or Soft Covered Books, Ceramics, Pots & Pans, Diapers, Toys, Organics or Alcoholic Beverage Containers</p>	

Waste Wood and Brush - Burn Pile: Will only be accepted at the Brudenell Waste Site

Only clean uncoated wood and brush.

Construction & Demolition: Will only be accepted at the Brudenell Waste Site.

Painted or coated wood or wood with nails, screws or other hardware. Plywood, particle board or laminated panels. Plastics, furniture, leaves/grass and pine needles.

Metal and Appliances: Scrap metal can be disposed of in a specific area of the waste sites at no cost.

Appliances such as stoves, washers and dryers will be accepted at no charge.

Refrigerators and air conditioners may be disposed of in the metal area of the sites, provided the refrigerant has been professionally removed, as indicated by a tag installed by the service person.

Tires: Accepted at all sites – no charge, maximum 10 per day, must be clean, on or off rims.
