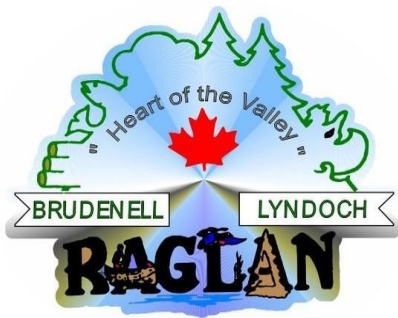

First-Aid Kit & Medications

Ensure you have necessary prescriptions and emergency medical supplies.



Extra Blankets & Warm Clothing

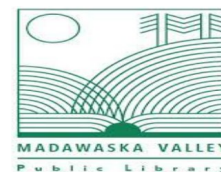
